NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), class rules, the rules of WFPHRF, this Notice of Race, and by the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility

2.1 The event is open to any self-righting, enclosed cabin sailboat and multi-hull that conforms to class rules and holds a valid WFPHRF certificate.

3.1 The Entry fee for this event is \$85.00 or \$76.50 with proof of current US Sailing membership.

4.1 Divisions will be PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF Non-spinnaker, PHRF True Cruising, and PHRF

4.2 The Race Committee may combine or divide Divisions based upon the number of entries. A

boat will not be placed in another without consultation with that registrant. The race

commitee may combine divisions for starts based on the number of boats in each division.

5.1 The races on Saturday, October 7th will be buoy races in the vicinity of San Carlos Light (SC). The race committee will attempt to run up to five races.

5.2 The race on Sunday, October 8th will be a distance race with the start and finish in the vicinity of San Carlos Light (SC).

5.3 GPS Coordinates for some or all of the marks to be used in the Sunday race will be published in the Sailing Instructions. Yachts are encouraged to have a GPS.

Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skipper and Crew Meeting and posted on the Summerset Regatta Official Notice Board, SummersetRegatta.com/rsvp prior to Saturday's racing.

The Yacht Scoring website SummersetRegatta.com/rsvp is the official site for ALL notifications. It is each boat's responsibility to check for changes on the Official Notice Board.

8.1 The low point scoring system will be used with no races excluded. This changes RRS

8.2 Corrected times will be calculated based upon Time-on-Distance PHRF RLC ratings. 8.3 One race constitutes a regatta.

9.1 Overall trophies will be awarded in the Sunday race, and in each Division combining all Saturday and Sunday races as follows:

9.2 Divisions with five or less entrants: First and Second Place

9.3 Divisions with six or more entrants: First, Second and Third Places

10.1 All boats shall carry a working VHF radio capable of sending and receiving on marine channel 72 and the weather channels.

10.2 A boat retiring shall notify the signal boat as soon as possible
